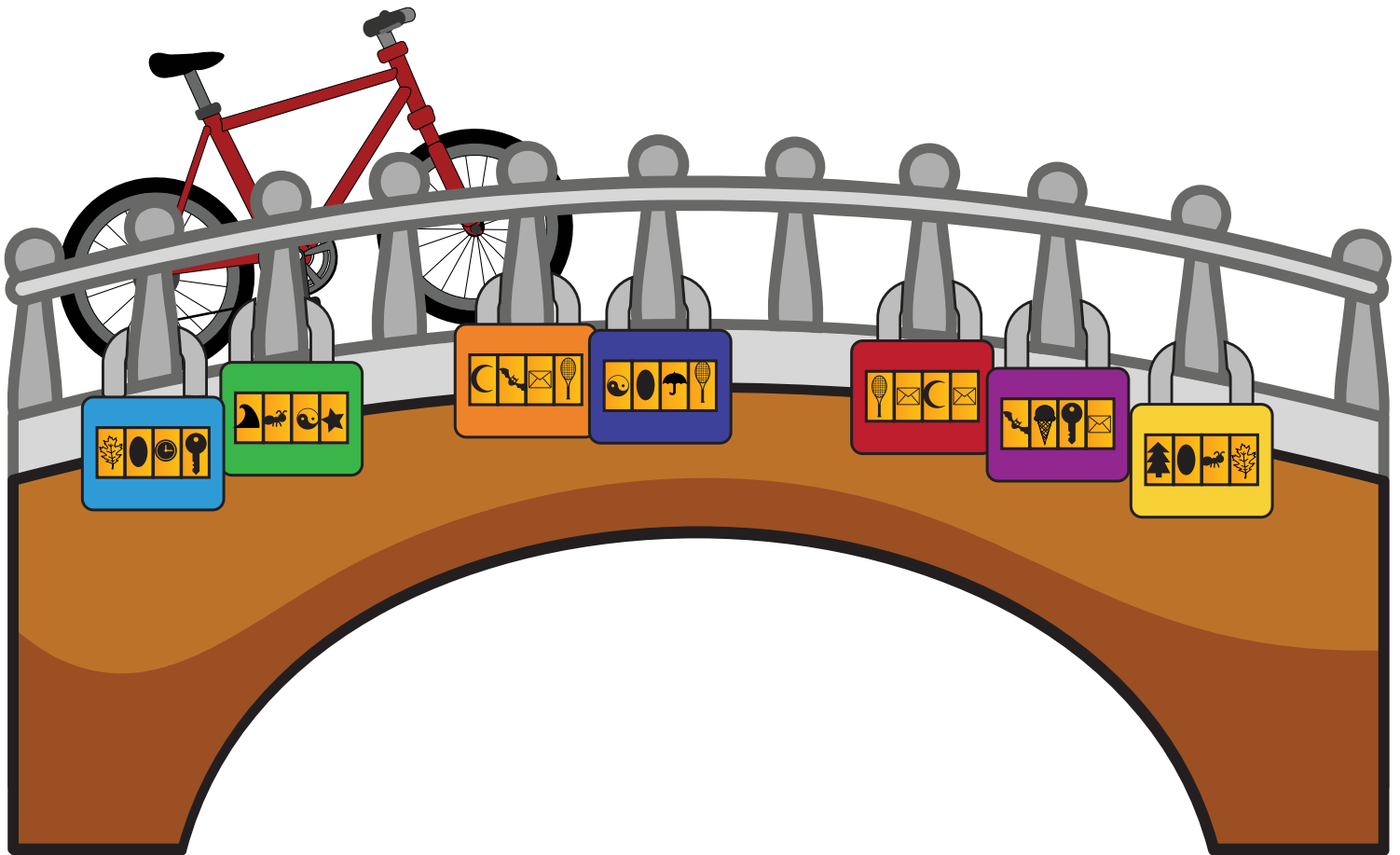


NOVA Loop Trail Puzzle Hunt
